TWO BIOVET KITS EVALUATED BY TWO INDEPENDENT REFERENCE LABORATORIES PASSED THE TEST WITH FLYING COLORS!

St. Hyacinthe, September 17, 2011. — Two Biovet ELISA kits for the serological diagnosis of two important bovine diseases have recently been evaluated by two independent reference laboratories.

The kits are for the diagnosis Enzootic Bovine Leukosis (EBL) and the diagnosis of *Neospora caninum* infections (NC).

The first kit was evaluated by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) Laboratory in St-Hyacinthe¹ and the second one by the Group SALUVET from the University of Madrid, Spain². The CFIA laboratory is the reference laboratory in Canada for the LBE and the Group SALUVET is a renowned research center for studies on *Neospora*.

The results demonstrated the high quality of the two kits and position them among the best products of their categories on the market today:

Test	sensitivity	specificity
EBL	100% (CI 95% : 94.9% -100%)	100% (CI 95% : 95.3% -100%)
NC	98.9% (CI 95% : 97.6% -100%)	98.9% (CI 95% : 97.4% -100%)

The Biovet EBL kit is also the only kit officially approved by the CFIA for serological diagnosis of EBL in Canada.

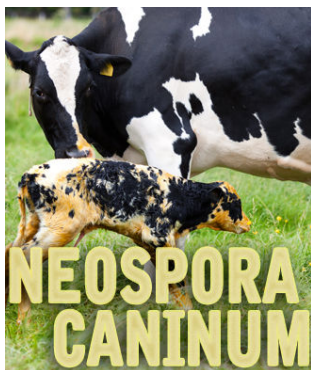
